## **REIMBURSEMENT TO STATES AND FCT**

he Nigeria COVID-19 Action Recovery and EconomicStimulus (NG-CARES) Programme now renamed Nigeria Community Action for Resilience and Economic Stimulus (NG-CARES) is a World Bank-supported intervention with a credit portfolio of 750 million US Dollars. The Programme Development Objective is "To expand access to livelihood support and food security services and grants for poor and vulnerable households and firms."

NG-CARES is a Programme for Results (PforR) Intervention where States and FCT invest their resources, produce results in line with agreed protocols and get reimbursed by the Federal Government after an Independent Verification Exercise.

The Federal Government has reimbursed 34 States and FCT the sum of Four Hundred and Thirty-Eight Billion, Three Hundred and Sixty-Eight Million, Nine Hundred and Fifteen Thousand, Thirty Naira and Twenty-Four Kobo (N438,368,915,030.24) after the Third Independent Verification Assessment.
